Moat Brae, Scotland's National Centre for Children's Literature & Storytelling, Dumfries, UK

the challenge

280 m² of liquid-vinyl polyurethane comfort flooring for use in a large sweeping atrium positioned at the entrance of a visitor attraction dedicated to children's literacy and storytelling.

meet the client

Moat Brae, a Georgian villa dating back to 1823, is home to the terraced gardens that are said to have inspired J M Barrie's classic children's story about the free-spirited boy who never grew up.

Today, the complex plays host to a children's centre, operated by the Peter Pan Moat Brae Trust, dedicated to literature and storytelling that is expected to attract more than 250,000 visitors per year.

the project

The Neverland-style complex, features exhibition space, reading and play areas, a shop, a cafe and rooms available to hire for special events. A performance space has also been created in the garden, alongside a pirate ship, Lost Boy's treehouse and mermaid's lagoon.

There is also an attic recreation of the Darling children's nursery, where visitors can attempt to catch Peter Pan's shadow, or crawl through Nana's kennel into a play theatre.


meet the installer
